Dear MSA Members,

With the COVID-19 situation in Manitoba constantly evolving we will continue to provide updates to our membership as it relates to the soccer community as soon as we receive them.

WESTMAN REGION

It was announced that the Prairie Mountain Health Region has been moved into the province's Restriction Level beginning Monday, August 24th. The Manitoba Soccer Association, in conjunction with the Westman Regional Soccer Association, decided to move that region of the province into Stage 1 of the Manitoba Soccer Return to Participate Guidelines and Recommendations, following provincial health authority guidelines of maximum group sizes of 10 people.

We have since received clarification from Sport Manitoba and the provincial health authorities that the maximum occupancy of 10 people indoors and outdoors does not apply to sport activities. With this information the Manitoba Soccer Association and Westman Regional Soccer Association have moved that region of the province into Stage 2 of the Manitoba Soccer Return to Participate Guidelines effective immediately. All other areas of the province remain in Stage 3.

We want to remind our membership that this situation is fluid and constantly changing, and that decisions are made on a day to day basis. We urge that all members continue to follow the Return to Participate guidelines and recommendations set forth by the provincial health authorities and Manitoba Soccer regarding sanitizing, physical distancing, and self-assessing when attending any sanctioned soccer activities.

Please remember that we must continue to work together to mitigate the risk of COVID-19.
